

The Annual Alateen Recertification Window Opens January 9, 2025!

Every year, each Area in the World Service Conference Structure is required to take part in the Annual Alateen Recertification process in order to continue to use the Alateen name. The 2003 Alateen Motion from the Board of Trustees (see the Appendix of the *2022-2025 Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual* [P-24/27] v4) and the policy for Alateen (beginning on page 93 of the *Service Manual* v4) explain this.

The recertification process is twofold:

1. To verify that every registered Alateen group has currently certified Al-Anon Members Involved in Alateen Service (AMIAS):
 - as Group Sponsor(s)
 - as the Current Mailing Address (CMA) for the Alateen group
 - as a Phone Contact for the public for the Alateen group
2. To verify the current certification of all AMIAS

We ask that all Areas complete the Alateen recertification by June 15, 2025!

This year, completing your recertification well ahead of the June 15 deadline will help with the selection of AMIAS to support Alateen meetings at the 2025 International Convention of Alcoholics Anonymous, July 3-6, in Vancouver, BC.

Contact your Area Alateen Coordinator, Area Alateen Process Person, or District Representative to verify the process in your Area. Don't miss this opportunity to share your recovery with teens and younger members!
